

NATIONAL HEALTH SERVICE (NHS)

General information:

The National Health Service (NHS) is the UK's state healthcare system providing a wide range of health care services including appointments with a doctor (general practitioner or GP), hospital treatment and dental care.

If you are on a course lasting six months or more you can receive treatment from the National Health Service (NHS) from the beginning of your stay and free of charge at the Doctor's surgery, a Healthcare Centre or in a hospital.

You may need to pay for any medicine prescribed by the doctor and collected from a Pharmacy for which there is normally a standard charge of £8.40. If you need to have continued medication, you may find it cheaper to get a Prescription Pre-payment Certificate.

Registration with a GP:

You must register in advance with a general medical practitioner (GP) in order to make the best use of this service. If this is not done, it is much more difficult to obtain advice or to be routed to others for special attention, at short notice.

It is therefore recommended that everybody in the College should be registered with a general practitioner (GP) in Cambridge (see list overleaf).

You must register in person, and we suggest that you opt for a practice close to where you are living.

The closest GP surgeries to College are Newnham Walk Surgery and Trumpington Street Medical Practice (see overleaf for details).

Tier 4 students: you cannot register with an NHS GP if there is less than six months until your visa expires.

Therefore if you do not register, and fall ill towards the end of your course (less than six months), you will most likely have to pay for private medical care.
